Our school has been consistently securing 100% results in the AISSE from 2005 onwards. Nikitha R and Anagha Jayan secured First and Second position, Krishnaveni and Anagha Raj secured Third position in AISSE 2022.

School was reopened on first June. KG classes began on 8<sup>th</sup> June with the celebrations of KG Praveshanotsav in a colourful manner with beautiful and wonderful Programmes.

Pooja Pradeep and Navaneeth P of IX<sup>th</sup> Std were elected as school Girl Captain and Boy Captain respectively.
